The monsters are donated to Social Work teams right across the UK and there is a huge need for them.

**Approved BS or CE labelled toy stuffing for your monster will be available from participating Inspire libraries. Please only knit, craft, sew and crochet stuffed Worry Monsters for this project (no hand puppets this time please).**
