




Nose cone, glue hatched area to secure overlap


Be inspired, and make a paper mouse!

You will need:

- Scissors
- Pen/Pencils/Felt tips
- Glue stick/Clear tape

How To:

1. Cut out the mouse shape by **cutting around the solid black outline**. Then use crayons or felt pens to add shading and decoration.
2. **Roll the mouse's nose into a cone shape** - start from the point of the mouse's nose, **overlap the paper at the hatched area** and apply a little glue or sticky tape to secure the cone in place.
3. **Roll the body under, starting at the back**. Keep rolling until the back feet match with the front feet. Apply glue to the hatched areas and secure in place.
