How To: Make a boat for the Myriorama water and a bird for the Myriorama sky!




BOAT

- 1 Cut out around the solid black outline.
- 2 Fold in half diagonally on the dotted line.
- 3 Fold the sail on the dotted line.
- 4 Open and refold dotted lines in reverse.
- 5 Glue the tab to close the stern (back).
- 6 Decorate.



BIRD


- 1 Cut out around the solid black outline.
- 2 Fold in half diagonally on the dotted line.
- 3 While folded cut the wings on the solid line.
- 4 Fold the dotted lines to open the wings.
- 5 Decorate.
