





'How To' Make a 3D Roman Pot Decoration

1. Cut out the pot and decorate front and back.
2. Fold into half along the short dotted line first.
3. Then fold into quarters along the long dotted line.
4. Cut along the three solid curved lines while folded.
5. Unfold carefully and open the cut sections in opposite directions to reveal the 3D centre.
6. Attach string and suspend.
