

### Things you will need

- Some things in your home sheet
- Pens

### What to do

1. Read out an item on the 'Some things in your home' sheet  
Think about what the 'something' could be
2. When you have thought of 'something' for each box, you could
  - tick that box
  - write your idea in that box
  - find the thing in your home and put it on your table  
(if you want a bigger space to write or draw, cut out each box and glue it to other pieces of paper)
3. Remember to put the items back carefully at the end of the activity

### Extra ideas

- **Sorting**
  - Put the items in a line from biggest to smallest
  - Group the items into things that are soft and things that are hard
  - Group the items into things that cost more than £5 or less than £5  
Can you think of other ways to sort the items?
- **Treasure Hunt** – if you are with other people
  - One person goes into a different room and hides all the items
  - Other people then take turns to try and find an item
  - You can make it harder by asking each person to find a specific item, 'can you find the something that .....?'
- **Letter challenge**
  - Choose a letter of the alphabet  
Why not start with the first letter of your name?
  - Try and think of something for each box that starts with that letter.  
You might need to include things that are not in your home.
