

How to make a 'Home Cooked' paper mince pie

You will need:

This sheet
Pens & pencils
Scissors
Glue or tape
Decorations



1 Cut out the mince pie base and pie crust shapes along the solid outlines. Use coloured pens and pencils to decorate the pie.

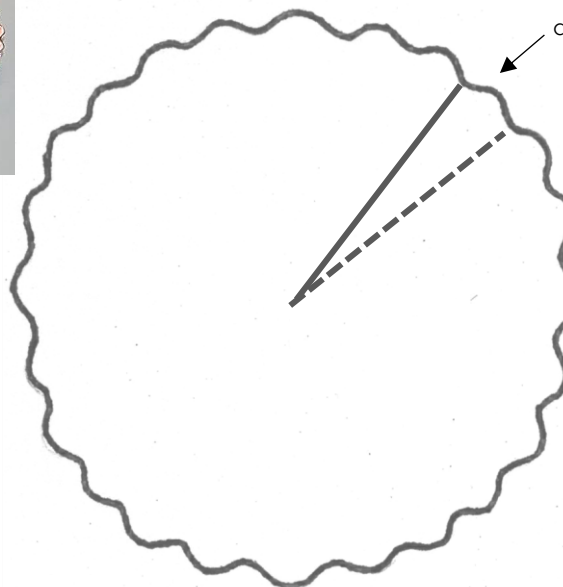


2 Glue or tape the tabs (a, b & c) to close the open edges and create a 3D pie crust and base.

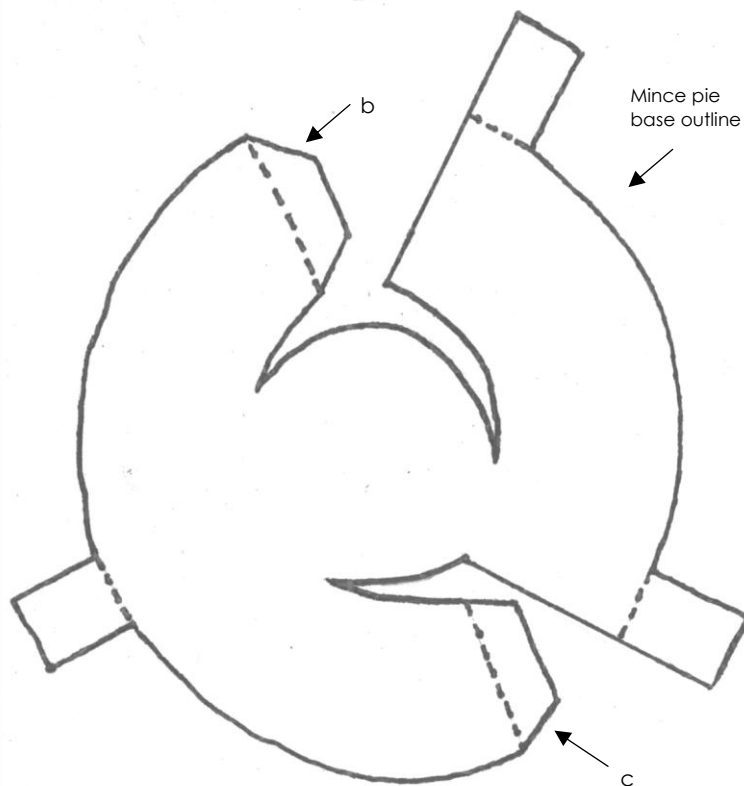


3 Attach the base and the crust together by gluing the 3 square tabs, then sprinkle with more decorations if required!
