What to do

1. You can print the quiz sheet or read the questions on the screen.

For each thing, see if you can work out

You could write a story or draw a picture to show what you have found out.

The Countryside Code is a set of rules for people to follow when they are out in the countryside.

The countryside is fields, woods, parks, paths, nature reserves.

The rules tell us how to keep safe and how to help protect the animals, plants and wildlife.
