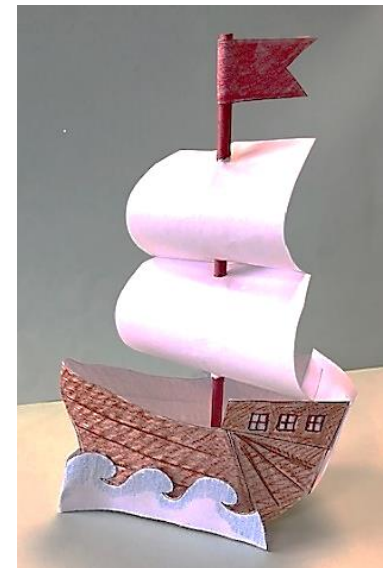
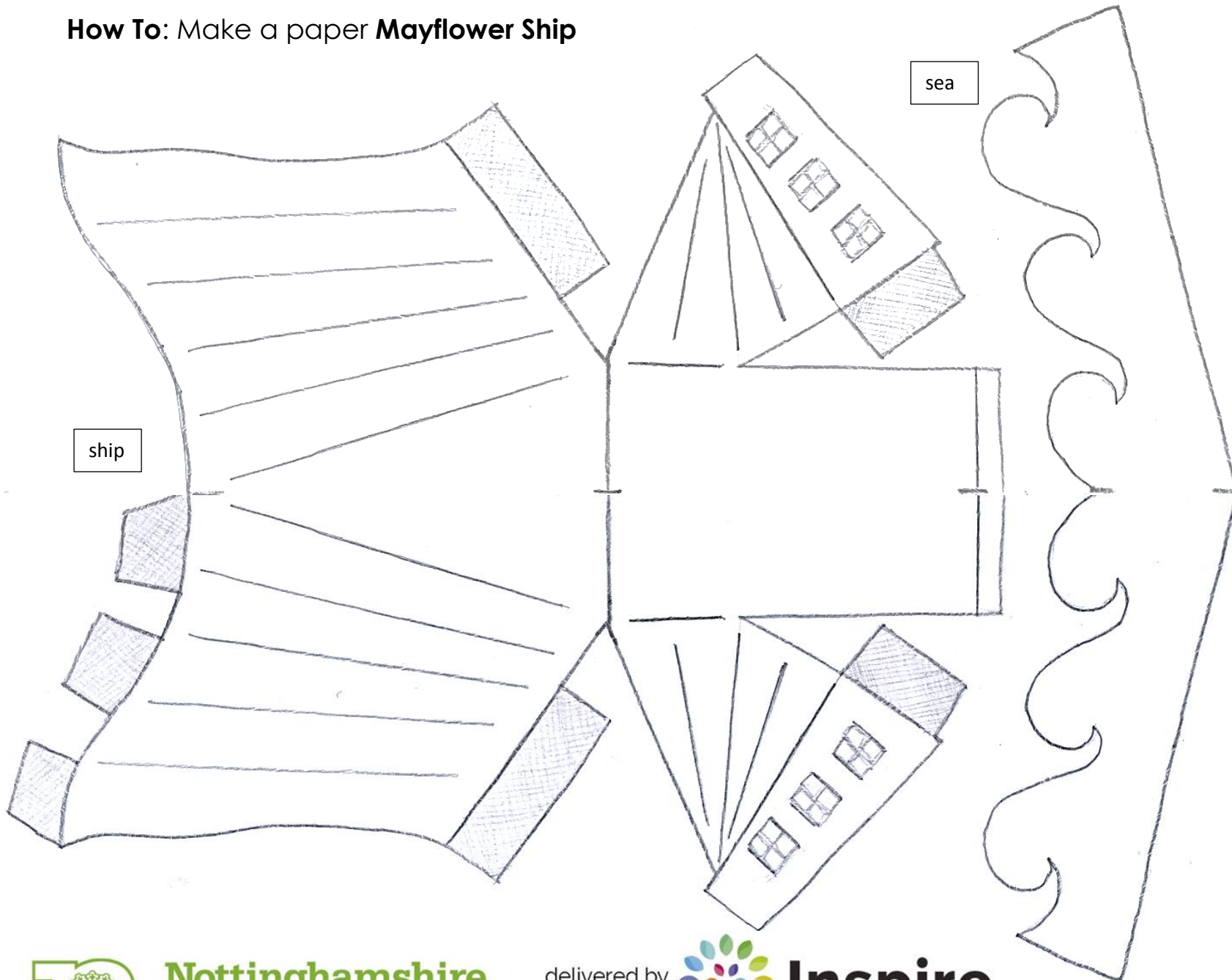
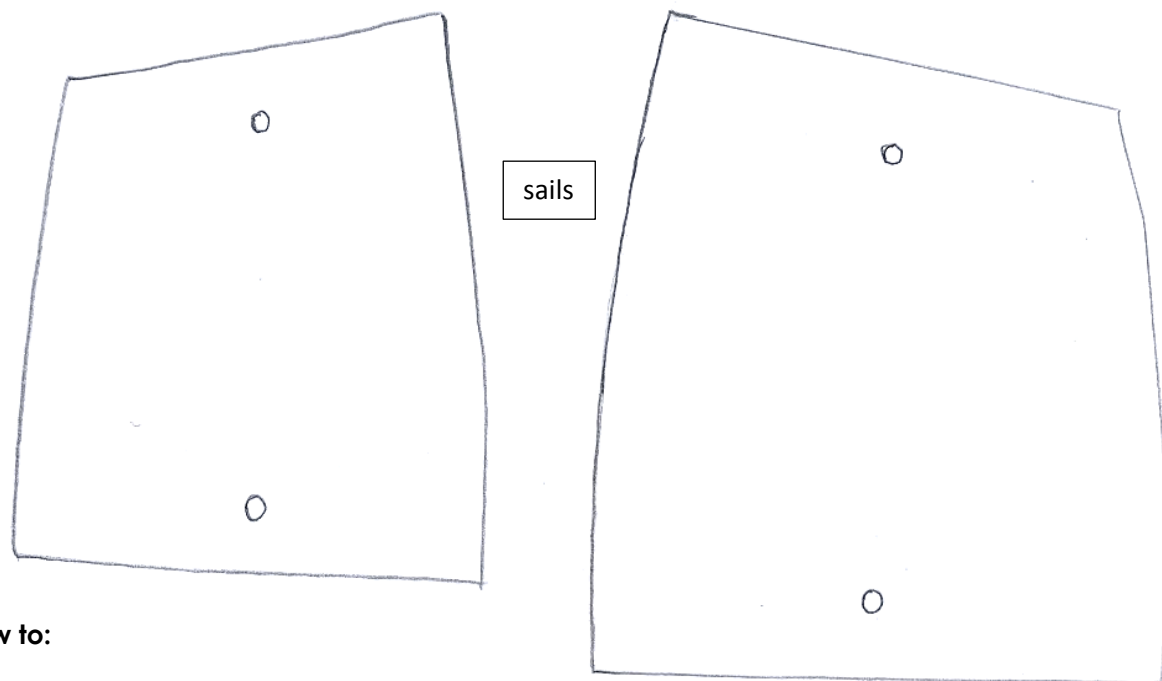


How To: Make a paper Mayflower Ship



- You will need:**
- Paper Mayflower templates
 - Coloured pencils or pens
 - Glue
 - Scissors
 - Blue tack
 - Paper craft straws

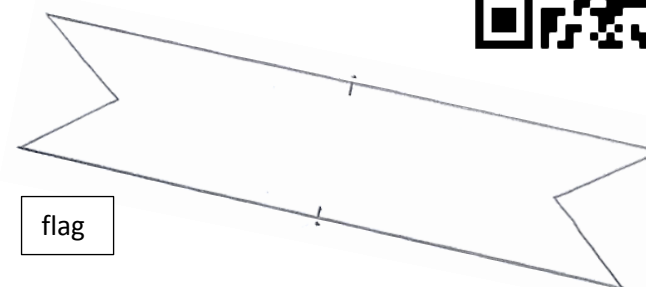


2020 marks 400 years since the Mayflower set sail for America with pilgrims from Nottinghamshire on board.

How to:

- (1) First colour and cut out all the parts; ship, sails, flag and sea.
- (2) Assemble the ship by gluing all the tabs to join the sides.
- (3) Make holes in the sails by pushing a sharp pencil through the paper into blue tack, then thread the sails onto a paper craft straw mast (19 cm) and glue the small flag to the top.
- (4) Snip the end of the straw mast to open it out - glue it to the inside bottom of the ship (centrally).
- (5) Finally attach the sea.
