Allosaurus wants to write a book about herself but other dinosaurs want to be in it as well. Informative story about different dinosaurs.

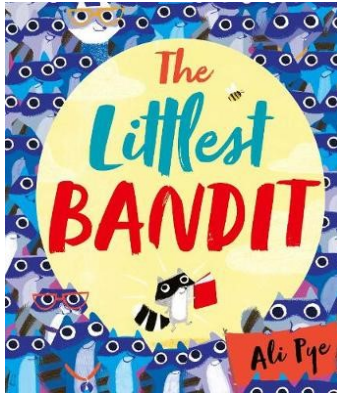

Rhyming introduction to each of the planets in the solar system with muted retro illustrations.

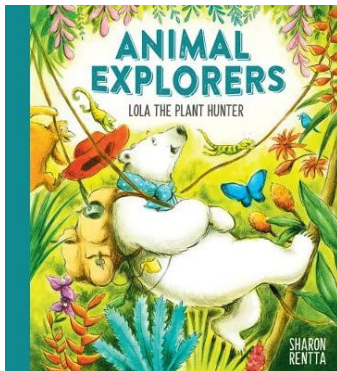

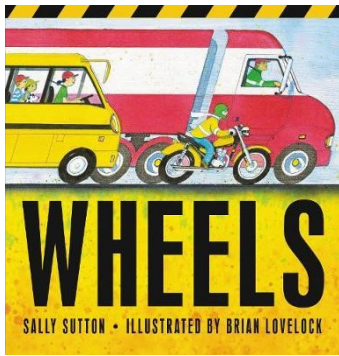

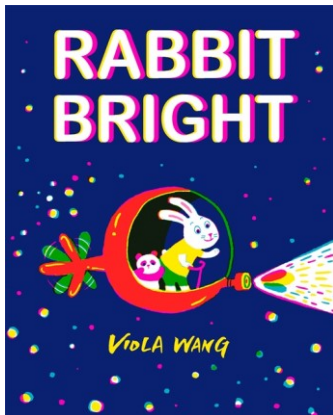


Sutton, Sally
