Comparison of 17/18 Destinations and Impact of Community Learning (CL) Results

Overview

We have put together this comparison data document to give our local authority clients an indication of how their destination and impact results compare with those of others.

Please bear the following in mind when reading this document:

- The dataset is of general CL provision and a sample of CL provision was provided by each Council.
- The dataset provided by each Council comprised a range of locally provided courses.
- Short duration courses were mainly excluded. Each Council individually decided on the definition of a "short duration" course.
- Each Council provided datasets comprising of a different ratio of CL-funded courses depending on local provision.
- The comparison percentages are a combination of results gathered during the telephone surveys conducted by J2 Research.
- Throughout this document, the mean average percentage of the aggregated results has been used.
- Some of the destination codes which produced statistically insignificant returns have been removed for ease of comparison.
- The data for each individual provider is not shared with any other institution. Only the collective results of the amalgamated data are ever used.
- Although we work with approximately 20% of adult CL providers, not all were able to commence the project in time to be included in this benchmarking exercise.
- Included in the report are the results of 17,000 CL learners.
- The codes used throughout this comparison report are the 17/18 ILR destination codes.
