Make Folded Stars



To make folded stars you will need:

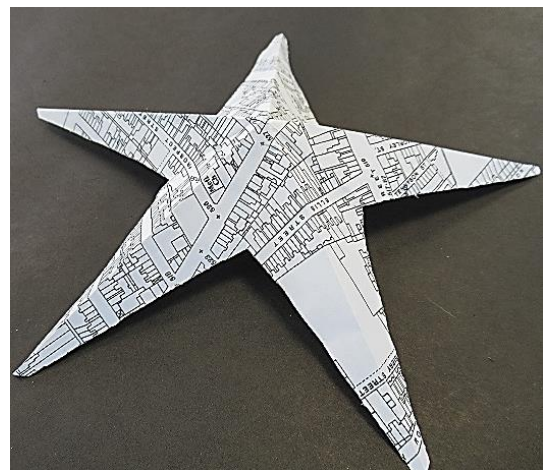
Paper
Scissors
Pencil

Find an old map of your town centre.

Take A4 photocopies of an interesting section of the map in black and white (it's okay to photocopy a map if it's more than 50 years old).

'How To' make a folded Star

1. Draw round the star template on map paper, cut out.
2. Fold the map star along the dashed lines indicated on the diagram below.
3. If the long folds to the centre are pinched and encouraged upwards and the short folds to the centre are pinched and encouraged downwards the star will appear 3D.
4. Make different size stars, add collage and decoration, use different papers.
