## **Make Folded Stars**



## To make folded stars you will need:

Paper Scissors Pencil

Find an old map of your town centre.

Take A4 photocopies of an interesting section of the map in black and white (it's okay to photocopy a map if it's more than 50 years old).

### 'How To' make a folded Star

- 1. Draw round the star template on map paper, cut out.
- 2. Fold the map star along the dashed lines indicated on the diagram below.
- 3. If the long folds to the centre are pinched and encouraged upwards and the short folds to the centre are pinched and encouraged downwards the star will appear 3D.
- 4. Make different size stars, add collage and decoration, use different papers.
