

Inspire Learning Study Programmes – Online Learning Statement January 2021

As well as continuing to provide face to face provision for vulnerable learners, Inspire Learning has in place a comprehensive programme of online learning to mitigate the effects of the current restrictions on our Study Programme learners who are staying at home.

In addition to having his or her own Microsoft Learning account, every learner will be provided with a laptop and for those who do not have access to the internet at home, a connectivity device will also be available.

Experience of the first lockdown, along with investment in equipment and a commitment to staff professional development, has enabled us to enter the current lockdown in a much better position to provide continued quality teaching and learning via online access for all learners.

Sessions will take place on learners' original days of attendance and will be delivered via Microsoft Teams and work will be completed as originally planned for each course.

In cases of vocational courses with practical elements, tutors may make short-term adaptations to the programme in terms of focus upon theoretical elements and virtual access to a specific vocational sector.

Inspire Learning will continue to plan for a return to face to face delivery after February half-term; however, we will monitor the situation and respond to current government guidance. All learners, parents and carers will be kept up to date via tutor communications and this website.
