We're excited to announce our new artist development and record label, eNGine Room! eNGine Room is our not-for-profit label, supporting and showcasing some of the best young talent emerging in Nottinghamshire, and is supported by Arts Council England.

We aim to develop artists with a focus on a range of tailored support - songwriting, recording, production, performance. marketing and promotional campaigns and releasing - to suit the development of young and emerging musical talent across Notts.

Artists from the music programmes will then have intensive sessions going forward, the style of which will depend on their needs, to develop them to a level where they can record and produce material for release on the label and for performance at IYA events and showcases. external and partnership events.

eNGine Room will be partnered with a team of associate artists and producers, designed to equip the young musicians with the best advice and tools for the development of their professional careers within the industry.

The label will also provide opportunities for young artists to work on film, media. photography and promotional aspects of the label to help foster and develop their careers within the creative industries.



The label has already released Able Orchestra's 'The SUMP Collective Chill Remix' on 21 May. and a busy 2021 of releases is already scheduled, beginning with Jack Chapman's 'Paper Planes' on 4 June. Other artists recording and releasing their first singles over the next few months include Sam Barker, Margarita. Stan Buckroyd and Sam Adams, as well as the CRS Collaboration.


