

Inspire Learning Study Programme Maths and English COVID Additional Support Strategy

Inspire Learning recognises that in spite of the best efforts of schools, colleges and other providers, many learners have experienced the negative impact of COVID-19 shutdown and this has affected their progress in Maths and English.

To address this, our Study Programme provision is committed to providing additional maths and English support to those learners (aged 16 to 19) who are yet to achieve a GCSE grade 4 in either of those subjects.

This support will be delivered within smaller groups (no more than 5 learners), allowing support staff to spend more time with each learner, focusing upon their individualised targets.

To achieve this, Inspire has employed additional staff and these extra sessions are timetabled as part of a learner's programme. We have also purchased extra online resources that allow learners to follow an individualised programme based on their initial and diagnostic assessment, delivered from not only our premises but also from home, where appropriate. Any learner who does not have access to a laptop and/or the internet at home will be lent the necessary connectivity and computer hardware for the duration of their programme.

Inspire learning is committed to addressing the impact of the pandemic on its learners. Should a future closure of face-to-face provision be required (i.e. either an individual base or the County-wide provision), our learners will remotely receive the same quality of learning and level of support at home as they are offered from out centres.

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
