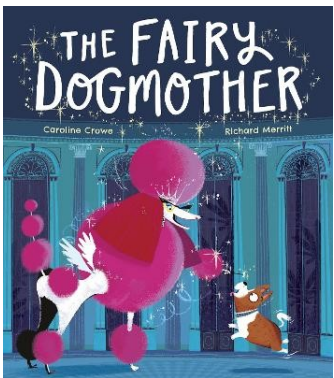

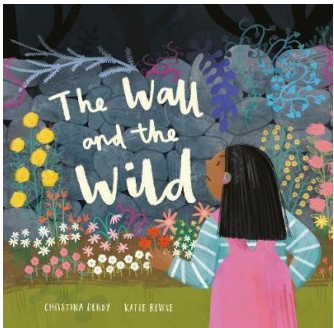
What jobs could you do

A lively introduction to lots of jobs, thinking about the qualities and characteristics required for each. Bright colourful illustrations.



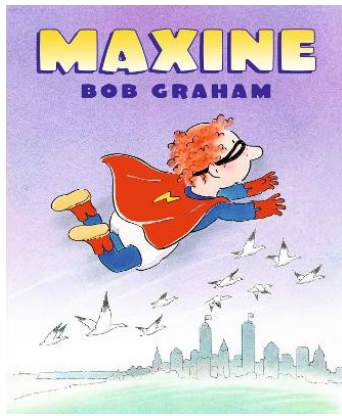
The fairy dogmother

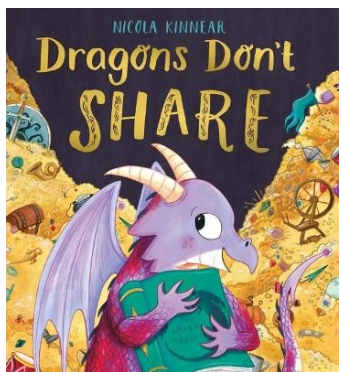

A celebration of individuality, encouraging the reader to think about themselves, their families and friends, and the parts each play in making up who they are. Bright colourful illustrations and rhyming text.

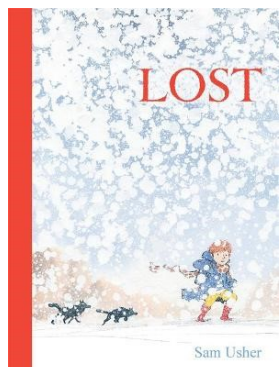

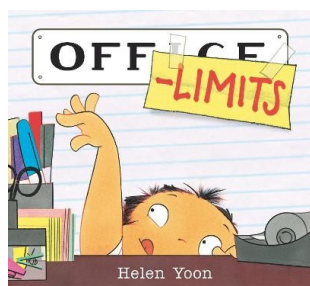
