## You will need:

- -1 pen or pencil
- 1 red pencil crayon
- -1 blue pencil crayon
- -1 pair of 3D glasses

## 1. Draw your character



What shapes make up this owl? Try drawing them in the space below with your red pencil. You can use Picture 2 to help you.



This is a great start! Now use your blue pencil to add details, texture and an outline based on the shapes.



Once you know the basic shapes to use, you can experiment with poses and outfits. This little owl is going to space!

Take a look at your finished red and blue drawing through the red lens of your 3D glasses. What do you see?

Yes, all your working out shapes in red have magically disappeared! You can see your finished drawing clearly.
