

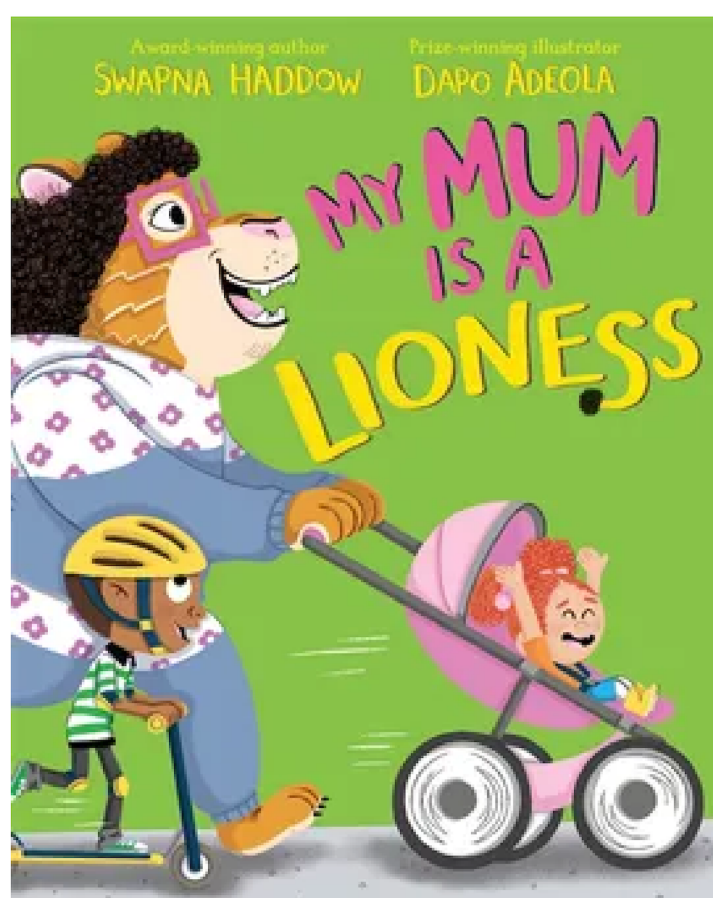


## My Mum is the Best

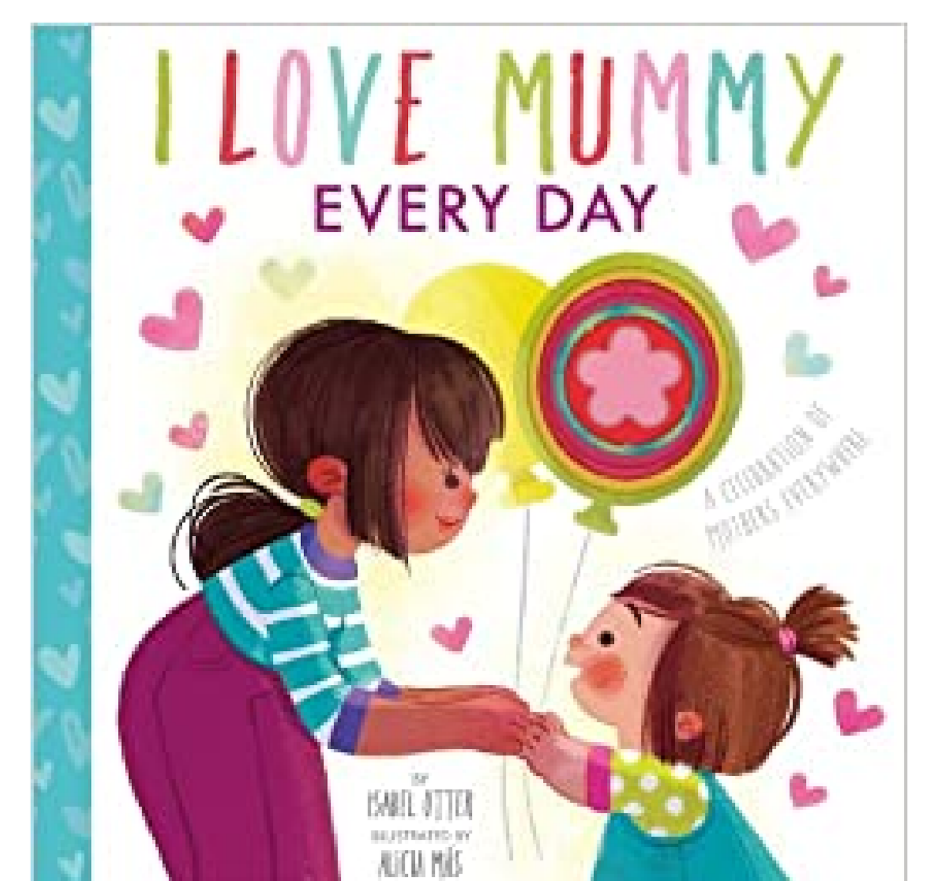


## My Mum is a Lioness

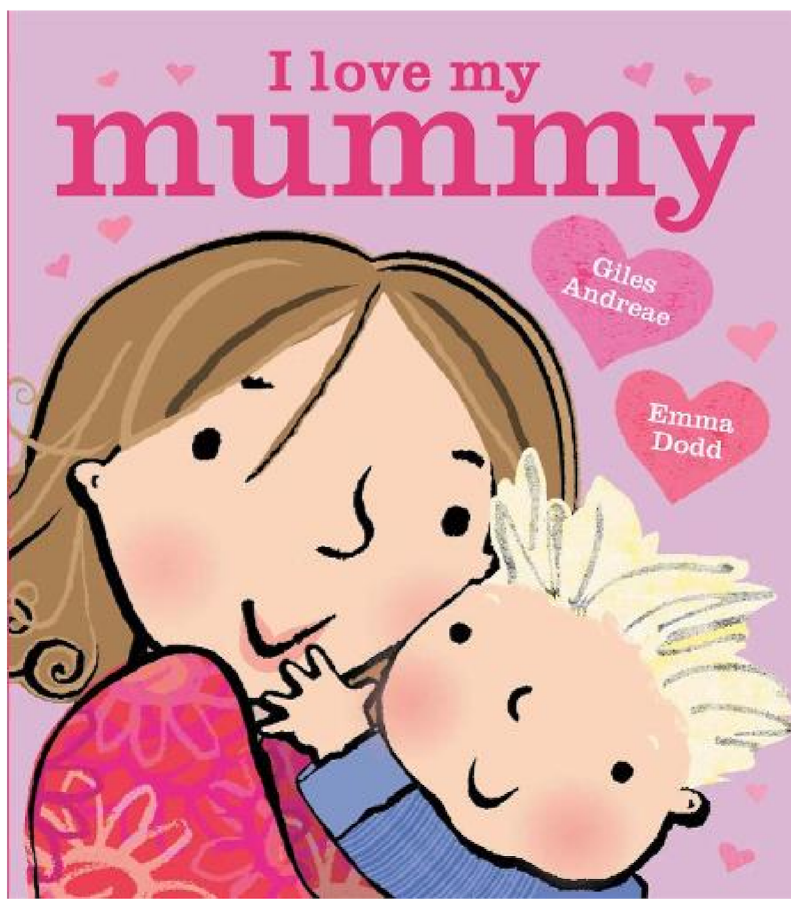

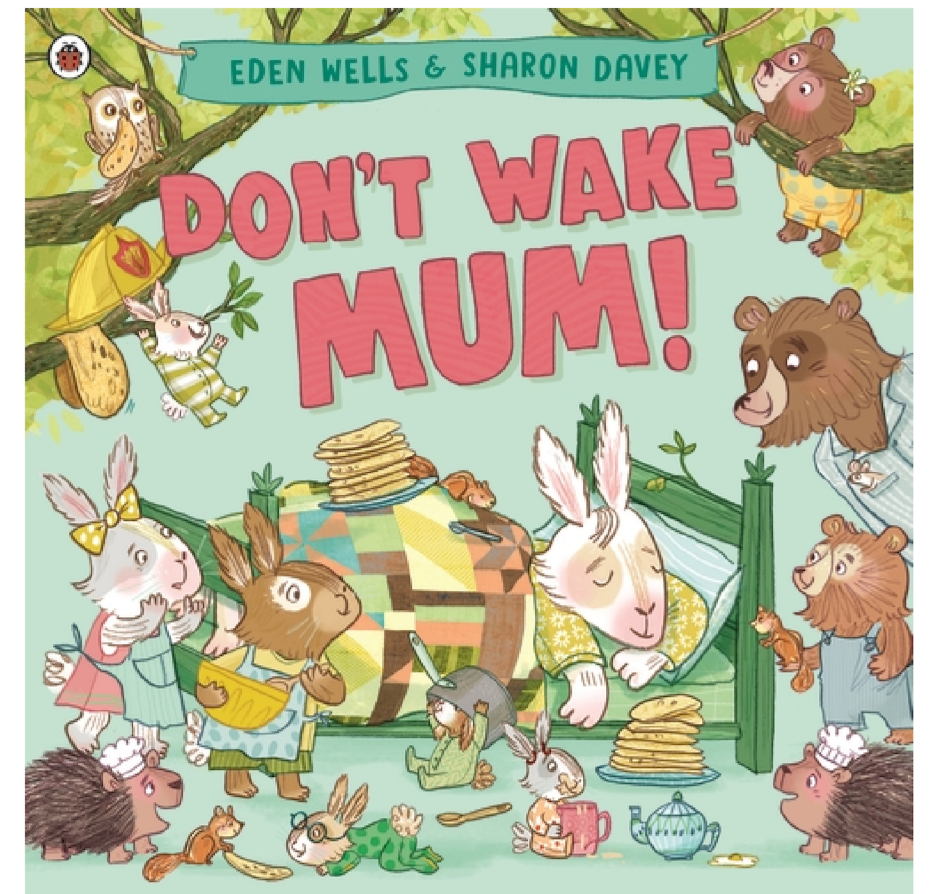


## I Love my Mummy
