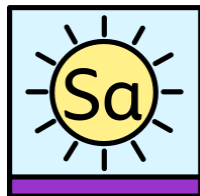

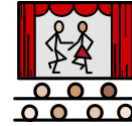

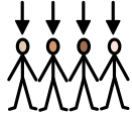

It is for everyone.

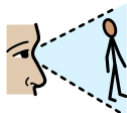
Able Orchestra is also called **AO**.

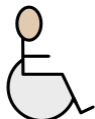

These activities take place across Nottinghamshire.

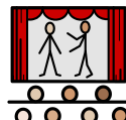
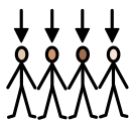
Inspire Youth Arts

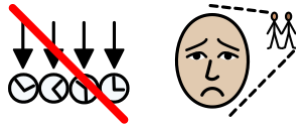

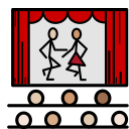
