





Claybourne, Anna Evolution for Curious Kids

Accessible guide to evolution for young readers, with vibrant illustrations and clear text and diagrams. Includes information about key scientists and their important discoveries, such as genetics.




Claybourne, Anna A Whole World of Plants and Fungi


Evans, Tegan Ancient Greek Gods and Goddesses


Griffin, Annabel Animal Habitats


Hemming, Alice A Walk in the Dark


Llorca, Francisco Ancient Egypt


Martin, Claudia Journey Around the United Kingdom


Rafik, Yusef How to be an Eco Explorer

A really good guide to many aspects of planet Earth, and how it compares to other planets in the Solar System. Covers aspects of science and geography with bite sized text and accompanying photographs and illustrations. This is great for curriculum topics and interesting for browsing too.



Winter, Kate The Cave Explorer

Interest age: 7+ Reading age: 8+

Tells the story of the discovery of the Lascaux cave paintings in France in 1940 by a boy and his dog. It then goes on to explain what scientists have discovered about prehistoric life from this cave. Packed with information, and beautifully illustrated it brings the stone age to life. Includes some pull out gatefold pages.
