When?

Our community courses are short enough to try something new without a huge commitment.

They vary in length from half a day, or a day, to 2 hours each week over 6 to 8 weeks.

Most of the sessions take place at local libraries or community centres, so they are easy to get to wherever you live. They're fun, friendly and nothing like school – why not go along with a friend or family member. Everyone is welcome!

Who is it for?

Our courses are for everyone aged 19+.

You don't need any skills or qualifications to take part and sessions are just for fun, so although we ask you to complete the course there are no exams at the end.

Some of the sessions are family learning, which means a parent or carer can learn at the same time as their child/ren. It's a great way to spend quality time together.

Our staff have lots of experience working with people with learning difficulties. We have a selection of courses that might interest you. Just get in touch and we can advise you on what is available.

How much does it cost?

Our courses are £3 per hour but **FREE** if you're in receipt of means-tested benefits.

Some courses may ask you to bring materials or ask for a small payment to cover material costs. If so, that information will be on the course details page on our website.

Payment should be made in full at the time of booking unless you qualify for a free place. If you would like to pay by phone, need further help with payment options or spreading the cost of your course, please call us on the number below.
