Our bases are open from September to July. The programme is personalised to you and you work at your own pace. You're also given time off over summer, at Christmas and Easter, as well as half-term breaks.

Will I get paid?

We pay a bursary to all students aged 16-19 (up to 24 with an EHCP; the rate is dependent upon your circumstances).

All travel costs are refunded and you may be entitled to free meals. Child benefit is not affected.

What's a Study Programme?

On our Study Programmes, you'll work with us for 3 days per week towards a recognised City and Guilds or Aim Awards qualification, as well as maths and English.

Study programmes at Eastbourne House, Sutton-in-Ashfield

- Level 1 and 2 Skills for Employment and Further Learning, including: citizenship, employability and personal and social development.
- AIM Awards Level 1 in Health and Social Care.
- AIM Awards Level 1 in Construction.
- AIM Awards Level 1 in Joinery.
- AIM Awards Level 1 and Level 2 in Painting and Decorating, including plastering.
- AIM Awards Level 2 in Catering.
- AIM Awards Level 2 in Food Safety.
- GCSE Maths and English (for students who have achieved a D/3).
- City and Guilds Functional Skills in Maths and English.

What's a Traineeship?

A Traineeship lasts up to 6 months and involves extended work experience for which you are paid a daily bursary whilst in placement.

We help you to find work experience in an area suitable for you and help you to improve your employability skills, build your CV, as well as improve your maths and English if you are yet to achieve a C or 4 in either.
