

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Access to Higher Education - Health & Social Care

Do you want to go to university but don't have the qualifications you need? Access courses are for people aged 19+ who want to go to university but who may not have been in education for some time.

Our Access to Health and Social Care course will run at The Old Library, Mansfield and Beeston Library on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings from September 2018.

The course costs £2,850, however Advanced Learner Loans are available to cover this cost. If you progress on to a degree course the loan is written off so that you won't have to repay it.

Getting you back into work

The Building Better Opportunities Towards Work programme benefits people of all ages across Bassetlaw, Newark and Sherwood, and Ollerton districts, who are unemployed and interested in getting back into work, education or training.

Participants are supported by a Work Coach and Job Broker to develop an action plan, to help them achieve their job goals. Towards Work offers personalised and tailored solutions to support an individual's journey to personal progression and employment. The project links individuals with specialist local support and continued in-work services, resulting in job retention.

The project can help people obtain industry-standard training, for example, SIA Door Supervisor qualification and as a result has seen several people receive offers of full-time employment.

Inspire are now the Towards Work Disability Delivery Partner in the programme, covering **Greater Nottingham**, **Bassetlaw**, **Newark and Sherwood**, **Mansfield** and **Ashfield**, helping people with mental health Issues, people with physical disabilities and people with learning disabilities.













Courses for people with learning difficulties and disabilities

We work extensively with people who have learning and physical disabilities (LLDD). We also work with people who have mental health or other related needs. These courses are not advertised generally but are designed for pre-existing groups.

Last year we supported 3922 learners with learning and physical disabilities. We're proud of the learning experiences we're able to offer students, who might otherwise not be able to access learning.

Our courses for disabled people are for learners aged 19+, are free of charge and are taught by skilled tutors who are excellent in their field.

The courses are available in a variety of subjects, including:

- Out and about Independence skills
- Moving to music
- Motivation and confidence
- Film-making
- Massage and reflexology

How much does it cost?

All our courses are subsidised by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA). They cost just £4 per hour, but if you're in receipt of any of the following means-tested benefits your course will be free:

- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance (excluding contribution-based)
- Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support (excluding single person's discount)
- Employment Support Allowance
- Income Support
- Incapacity Benefit
- Working Tax Credit
- Pension Credit (excluding savings credit)
- Unwaged Dependents of those in receipt of the above benefits
- Identified elements of Universal Credit

How to pay

Unless you qualify for a free place, payment should be made in full at the time of booking. It may be possible to pay in instalments if you're unable to pay the full amount up front. If you would like to pay by phone, or need help with payment options, please call us on 0115 804 4363.

Some courses may ask you to bring materials. If so, this information will be on the course details page on our website or discussed at the first session.

At the first session, you'll be asked for some details to enrol you onto the course, please bring proof of benefits if you're hoping not to pay.


