Fees and funding

The cost of our courses varies, so please contact us for details or visit our website inspireculture.org.uk/learning.

As a Community Benefit Organisation, and not for profit, we can guarantee our prices are amongst the most competitive in the region.

If you are aged 19 or over on the day your course starts you may qualify for an **Advanced Learner Loan**.

We can support and guide you through the loan application if you study with us. The loan isn't means tested and you won't pay anything back until you are earning at least £25,000 a year.

If you choose to do an Access to Higher Education course, progressing to university and completing your university course, your Advanced Learner Loan will be written off, and you won't have to repay it.

Flexible payment options are also available.
